FIREWOOD ALERT!

The invasive and highly destructive emerald ash borer was recently spotted in Fairfax County. Authorities are trying to contain the spread, but in the meantime a federal order invokes a quarantine on firewood among other wood products into and out of Fairfax County (see https://www.vdacs.virginia.gov/press-releases-190403-invasive-pests.shtml for the latest official press release). To help prevent spreading this tree-killing insect, DO NOT TRANSPORT FIREWOOD ACROSS COUNTY LINES.
