After cleaning up, dispose of it in the trash—not chucking it into the woods or down a storm drain. By properly disposing of your pet's waste, you will provide a sanitary area for children to walk to school, improve the steams and lake water quality, and be a law biding citizen.

To property owners and renters: if someone neglectfully leaves the waste, please be the better person and pick it up for the above reasons. Doing so is more helpful than either leaving a festering pile or posting signs around it. Thank you.
